COMPETITION BRIEF

Young people and children account for a significant proportion of the population, and they often have differing mobility patterns and needs to the rest of the population.

The question in this case relates to pre-teen school students and early teen secondary school students and their mobility patterns and needs to enable them to travel more independently. Everyone's circumstances are different, the places they live (urban v rural), supervision required due to their age, the distances they need to travel and the transport networks available to them, all may vary. Therefore, enabling more independent travel may relate to any aspect of traveling safely with or without a parent or guardian on public transport, walking or cycling.



Increasing the numbers of young people and children travelling more independently can reduce private car journeys and help in the fight against climate change.
